AERHART releases debut record, WALLFLOWER, October 22nd. 2021

Aerhart released their debut full-length record WALLFLOWER on October 22, 2021. The 10-track LP is available on all streaming services and to digitally download for \$7 on Bandcamp.

Aerhart weaves acoustic and electronic instruments into a hybrid set of 10 songs spanning avant-pop, alternative, rock and electronica with detours into 2000's-era bangers, moody ballads, and pulsing dance grooves. Aerhart is the new project of Brooklyn-based vocalist, songwriter and producer Amelia Wellers. Working with producer Kyle Joseph (HYPOLUXO, ROLAND FAUNTE) during the COVID-19 quarantine, Amelia spent a year building out a home recording studio and making demos. Together, they produced WALLFLOWER with instrumental contributions by Sam Pearce, Godfrey Furchtgott, Spencer Inch, Bennett Eiferman, Laura Wolf, and mastering engineer Ryan Schwabe. Amelia had first worked with Kyle to release a 5-track folk EP last year under the name Awelia. But Aerhart soars beyond her folk roots and into turbulent waters with WALLFLOWER. The record has been likened to “whatever they play in the Vatican, but heavily electrocuted,” fronted by Joni Mitchell, with overtones of St. Vincent, My Brightest Diamond, and Radiohead.
